## Tuition

The cost for the seminar is \$2,500.00. This includes nine lectures and group coaching sessions, and five individual coaching sessions. The tuition is due before the seminar begins.

## Room & Board

There is a Room & Board charge of \$1100.00 for staying at the Roslyn Center. *This includes three nights lodging and nine meals for each of the three-day sessions.* This is payable at the beginning of the seminar.

## Commuting

For those wishing to attend the seminar as a commuter, there is a commuter fee of \$225.00 for the year, charged to us by the retreat center. This includes lunch each seminar day. Additional meals at the retreat center can be purchased ahead of time.

## Format

Nine days each year feature didactic training and discussions in the morning, video at lunch, and group coaching in the afternoon. Five individual coaching sessions are included. Three-year rotating curriculum can be entered in any year, with a one-year commitment at a time.
